








## What you need:

an adult's help,
scissors, felt, cord
or ribbon for handle
(about 60cm), hot glue
gun, scraps of braid to
decorate



- Decorate the front of one of the felt pieces by gluing on the braid. Glue one piece of braid scm from the bottom. The felt below this will be cut later to make a fringe. Glue the edges of the braid to the back of the piece of felt so it is neat at the front.
- 3 Glue the sides of the two pieces of felt together as far as the end of the braid scm from the bottom of the bag (remember the felt below this will
- 1 Using this braid as a guide, glue along the bottom of the bag.
- Of the bag up to the braid.
- 6 Glue the ends of the cord or ribbon to each side of the bag to make a handle.
